[Parents Guide] Instructions for HBL 2021

Role of Parents during HBL

<u>Guide the child to get ready</u>:

Set up an area conducive for learning, such as at the study desk or dining table. Make sure the child is familiar with the following :

- Passwords and Login IDs to gain access to the online portals that the school will be using.
- The HBL timetable and relevant materials needed for the child to complete her work.
- Point of contact for HBL queries. Teachers will inform the child about their preferred mode of communication – teachers are not required to share their mobile numbers.



Role of Parents during HBL

Agree on a structure

Unlike in school, an adult may not always be present to supervise the child. It is important to establish a routine with her on :

- Study, meal, rest timings
- "School" time (e.g. change out of pyjamas before starting HBL)
- "Recess" time (e.g. healthy, balanced diets)
- Recreation activities at home (e.g. reading story books, craft work, exercise)



 Recreation activities online (e.g. decide how much time she should spend online, behave responsibly online)

What Do Students Need To Do Everyday During FHBL?

- Login to their SLS before 8.00 a.m to check the assigned work / lessons for that day
- The instructions and assignments to be completed can be found in the "Class Announcement" tab on the main page.



Notes on Video Conferencing*

*Some teachers may conduct 'Live' lessons with students using video conferencing tools



Netiquette for Lessons with Video Conferencing

- □ **Students must be dressed appropriately** (*i.e. no singlets nor pyjamas*)
- Select an appropriate location at home (e.g. study room / living room / dining room. Do not take a video call in your bedroom or toilet).
- Ensure that their device is connected to a stable and strong wireless network.
- □ Ensure that the video is on and the face **can be seen** by all.
- The microphone must be muted when not speaking (otherwise there will be annoying feedback from the speakers).
- □ Be **punctual** for the sessions.
